Major Classifications of Faith Systems

- 1. Atheism Does not believe in God
- 2. Agnosticism Does not believe you can know there is a God
- 3. Deism Does not believe you can know God personally Agnosticism Vs. Deism
- 4. Pantheism believes god is everything
- 5. Polytheism believes in many gods
- 6. Humanism man is his own god
- 7. Monotheism

Understanding the Biblical Jesus

How do we explain why a man who lived 2000 years ago and only lived 33.5 years before he was executed as a rebel has been the most influential person to have ever lived?

Jesus was either Liar, Lunatic, or Lord.

Liar: If He claimed what He did and knew it wasn't true he shouldn't be followed.

Lunatic: If He claimed what He did and it wasn't true but he didn't know it, He was a lunatic (deluded) and shouldn't be followed.

Lord: If He claimed what He did and it was true, He should be followed because He is Lord.

I. His Claims

- a. Direct (explicit)
 - i. Personal outright declarations (John 8:58-59; John 10:30-33)
 - ii. His trial Here we see three of the most common claims

b. Indirect (implicit)

i. He forgave sins

- 1. The woman caught in adultery (John 8:1-11)
- 2. The man sick of the palsy (Mark 2:3-12)

ii. He exhibited authority (Psalm 50:4-6; Isaiah 40:21-31;Isaiah 45:5)

iii. Claimed noncommunicable attributes

 Pre-existence (Eternal) (John 8:58)
58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

- 3. Omnipresence (John 3:13)
